

ALPHABET FUN

<p><u>Alphabet Bingo</u></p> <p>Make an alphabet bingo game to play with your child.</p>	<p><u>Find It</u></p> <p>Ask your child to find all the things that start with a B and put them on his/her bed. Continue with other letters of the alphabet.</p>
<p><u>Grocery Store Letters</u></p> <p>When you come home from the grocery store, let your child sort out the canned goods. Have your child name what is in each can and tell you the beginning letter of the contents.</p>	<p><u>Dough Letters</u></p> <p>Mix salt/flour dough and have your child make the letters of the alphabet. When they are dry, display them in his/her room.</p>
<p><u>Label Your Room</u></p> <p>Help your child label the things in his/her room with the letter each one starts with.</p>	<p><u>Newspaper Alphabet</u></p> <p>Give your child scissors and an old newspaper page. Tell him/her to cut out certain letters, such as all the Cs, he/she can find. Do this with all the letters of the alphabet.</p>
<p><u>Riding in the Car</u></p> <p>Start with the letter A and see who can find that letter on a sign along the road. Continue through the alphabet.</p>	<p><u>Alphabet Book</u></p> <p>Write a letter on a piece of paper and let the child draw something that starts with that letter. Staple the drawings together and bind like a book.</p>
<p><u>Salt Tray</u></p> <p>Take the lid of a box like a shirt box and either paint the bottom black or cover it with black paper. Spread with salt and let your child make letters in the salt. Any mistakes can be wiped away. This is also good for the child to practice writing his/her name.</p>	<p><u>ABC Book</u></p> <p>Let your child make an ABC book at home. As we learn a letter at school, your child can find a magazine picture for the letter and paste it in the book at home.</p>
